NOTICE OF RACE

The Open Multi Class Event will include
The **CLASS CHAMPIONSHIP** for the Javelin and Sunfish classes.
The **CLASS EVENT** for the Flying Dutchman and Solo classes.

The event will be sailed on the IJsselmeer off Workum, the Netherlands, July 3 - 5 inclusive, 2009. The Championships are organized under the authority of Sailing Club Workum, in conjunction with The Royal Netherlands Yachting Union.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Royal Dutch Yachting Association will apply.
- 1.3 The 'Rules for Championships Sailing and Windsurfing' will apply.
- 1.4 Spare

- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing committee.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the: Sunfish, Javelin, Solo and Flying Dutchman classes
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and send it to the organizing authority. The entry form should be received not later than 10.00 hrs on July, 3rd 2009.
The entry form and information regarding fees and method of payment are available on the relevant class web-sites.
- 3.3 For a valid class championship a minimum of 20 competitors of each championship class must have entered for the regatta (see rule 13 of the Rules for Championships Sailing and Windsurfing).

7.3 On Sunday July 5, 2009 no warning signal will be given after 15:00 hrs.

8 MEASUREMENTS

8.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate when the boat is registered.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 08:00 on July 3 at the Regatta Office (located on camping "it Soal" in Workum).

10 VENUE

10.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour.

10.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

11 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be trapezoid with inner and outer loop.

12 Spare

13 SCORING

13.1 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

13.2 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

13.3 When from five to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13.4 When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

15 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

18 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

19 PRIZES

The winning boat in the Javelin and in the Sunfish class receives the title of Class Champion.

The class organizations will also make available a number of prizes.

20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

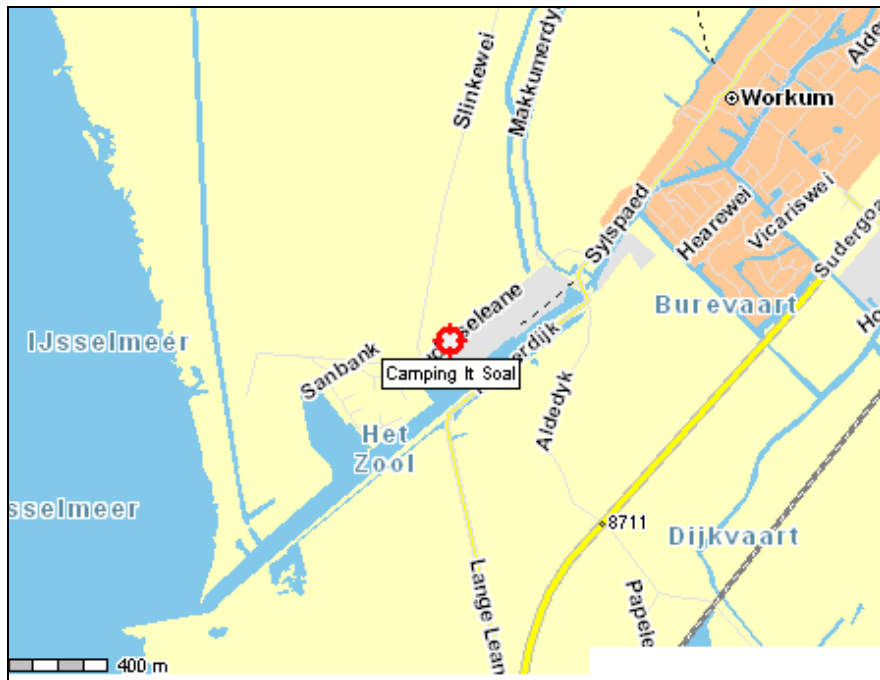
21 INSURANCE

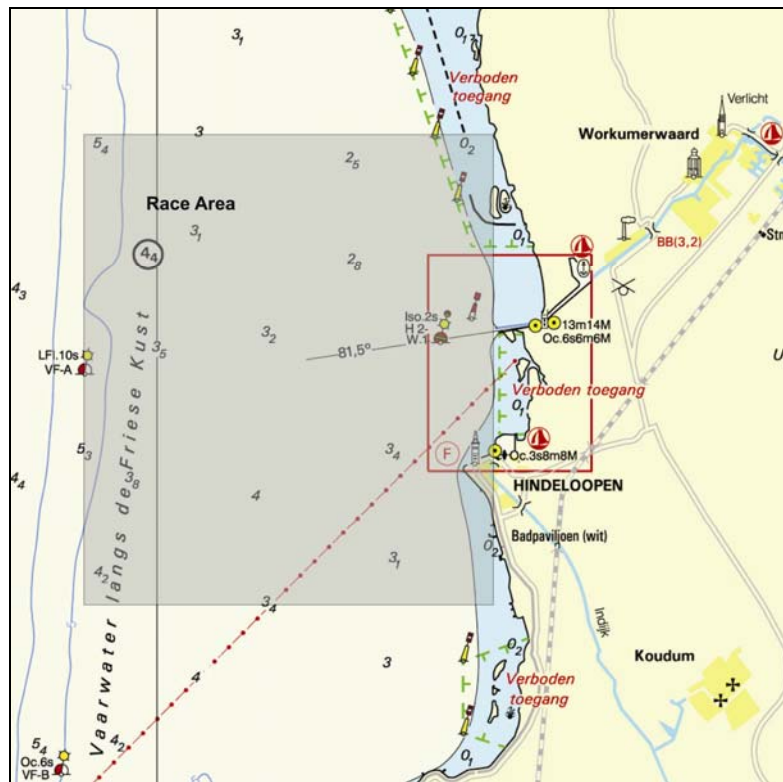
